2007 WCMA REGIONAL AUTOSLALOM SERIES SUPPLEMENTAL REGULATIONS

1. Events in the 2007 WCMA Regional Autoslalom Series will be run under the 2007 WCMA Solo General Competition Regulations and the 2007 WCMA Solo Event Regulations.
2. The WCMA Regional Autoslalom Series consists of 7 events:
 - a. Edmonton – ASA – June 10
 - b. Calgary – CSCC – July 15
 - c. Regina – QCMA – August 5
 - d. Saskatoon – SSCC – September 1
 - e. Saskatoon – SSCC – September 2
 - f. Winnipeg – WSCC – September 15
 - g. Winnipeg – WSCC – September 16

NOTE: Events dates are tentative and subject to change due to facility availability. Several events are actually 2 days in duration, although one day may count towards regional series points. Check with host clubs to confirm event dates and locations and registration requirements.

3. Any member in good standing of a WCMA affiliated club is eligible to collect points in the regional series. Club membership must be current at the time of the event to collect series points.
4. Competitor's must compete in at least 4 regional events (in the same class) to be eligible for awards. If a competitor competes in more than 4 events, their best 4 finishes will be used towards series awards.
5. Point Calculations
 - a. Calculation of the event points are as follows:
$$\text{Event Points} = (\text{Competitor's Best Time} \times 100) / \text{Best Time in Class}$$
 - b. Non-WCMA-affiliate members are not eligible for awards but their times are to be used in the above calculations.
 - c. All time penalties are to be included in the above calculations.
 - d. If a competitor receives a DNF (Did Not Finish) for every run, they will receive zero points for that event, but the event will still count toward their required 4 events.
 - e. If a competitor receives a DNS (Did Not Start) for every run, or is disqualified from the event, it will not count toward their required 4 events.
6. Year end awards will be given in each class based on the number of competitors completing 4 or more events in the class as follows:
 - 1-2 competitors in class: 1 trophy
 - 3-4 competitors in class: 2 trophies
 - 1 trophy for each additional 2 competitors
7. Competitors may only compete in a single class and a single vehicle at any given event (subject to vehicle substitution as per WCMA regulations and street tire class eligibility below).
8. In addition to the regular car classes outlined in the WCMA Solo Event Regulations (i.e. the Canadian Autoslalom Championship car classes), 3 additional Street Tire classes will be added for the series:
 - a. Stock Street Tire (ST)
 - b. Super Stock Street Tire (SST)
 - c. Street Prepared Street Tire (SPT)

Competitors running on street tires (treadware rating ≥ 140), will automatically be eligible for this additional class. Each class will be based on PAX times amongst all eligible competitors at each event within each category (Stock, SS, SP). Point calculations and number of awards will be the same as outlined above for the regular classes. Competitors must complete all runs in all WCMA Series

events on street tires to be eligible for awards in this class.

Non-competitors may ride along subject to regular WCMA rules for passengers and approval from organizers and other competitors.
