Notes for July 17, 2007 Conference Call

Present for the call: Dave Hull, Guillaume Couture, Christian Sorensen, Doug Campbell and Terry Epp. Cliff Loh was not able to attend and sent in a report.

Old Business:

Terry Epp is still waiting to present a proposal for a National SoloSport Committee Website, to the National ASN Board, as they have not had a meeting since the last conference call.

Update on the SoloSprint Technical Committee: Paul Van Tassel will be replacing Campbell Carlyle as CACC's representative on the Committee.

Lapping Regulation updates: Terry Epp will circulate a Bulletin to the Committee shortly summarizing the wording changes recommended by the various Regions.

Dual Slalom/Pro-Solo Rules: Cliff is gathering information on course design from SCCA contacts to include in the guidelines.

SoloSprint Results: The format for the SoloSprint Championship Results to appear in the SoloSprint Regulations Appendix has been sorted out, and the results from last year, will appear in the Regulations for this year's event, to be posted shortly.

2007 ASN Canada FIA Canadian AutoSlalom Championship September 1-3, 2007 by VCMC at Pitt Meadows, BC. Information and registration for the event is now available on the website: www.nationalautoslalom.ca

The Pitt Meadows facility is presently being paved. The area will be at least 1100' X 500'. Kumho will be awarding a set of tires to the Overall CAC Champion. Motul will be awarding product packages to all of the Class Champions. Driver's Edge will be awarding a prize package to the highest placing CAC "Rookie" (1st CAC event). Tire Trends will be awarding prizes to the winners of the Street Touring (street tire) Classes. Canadian Springs, M13 Energy Drinks, Blitzgear, and Tim Horton's are signed on as Event Suppliers. The Awards Banquet for the event will be held at a local golf course, with a Hawaiian theme. (Bring your flowered shirts!) An Evolution Mini School is being arranged for the AM of August 31st. Information to be confirmed shortly.

Dave Hull from the Committee will attend the event as an ASN Steward.

2007 ASN Canada FIA Canadian SoloSprint Championship. Hope to have more details on this event in early August.

QCMA has sent the Committee a proposed set of Drifting Regulations, they wish to use for some of their local events. The proposals seem quite workable, with the only concerns being completeness of the safety aspects taken from the AutoSlalom Regulations. The Committee has recommended using the AutoSlalom Regulations for the general safety of the event, and the club issuing a set of Supplementary Regulations covering the Drifting aspects of the event, such as classing, judging, etc.

Bids for 2008 National Championship Events. The Committee hopes to issue calls for bids for the 2008 events by August. The CAC event will be held somewhere in the East next year, and the idea for a Joint Event between the Ontario and Quebec Regions for the CSC event was floated by members of the Committee.
